4 New Features

The State of New Jersey, Department of Children and Families, Children's System of Care has requested a new Out-of-Home (OOH) Intensity of Service (IOS) called RTC-BH/DD (Residential Treatment Center-Behavioral Health/Developmental Disabilities). With the addition of the new IOS categories, four existing OOH provider sites need to have their IOS program type changed from RTC to RTC BH/DD. Once the new IOS / Program types have been added, the youth assigned to those providers will have their IOS / Program Type changed accordingly.

The following are the changes/additions that will be made for the Intensity of Service / Program Types.

- Out-of-Home(OOH) Provider Type will have a new IOS/Program Type:
 - RTC BH/DD
- The Annex A Addendums for the following providers will be changed by the CSOC Contracts Unit once the new IOS RTC BH/DD has been added to CYBER
 - Community Treatment Solutions (CTS)-Sequoia Grove
 - Community Treatment Solutions (CTS)-Redwood Grove
 - Community Treatment Solutions (CTS)-Cypress Grove
 - Willowglen-Demarest
- The youth who were previously in the IOS/Program Type for the above service providers (history) will be changed to the new IOS
- The youth currently admitted will reflect new IOS/program once changes are made in CYBER and admission data should only display as one episode of care.
- The changes will be reflected downstream in the following areas:

- Annex A, OOH PIF
- Updates to Provider Details: OOH Provider Grid, OOH Provider Search filters
- YL Grids (new IOS); YL IOS filter, OOH Specific Functions (YL)- IOS dropdowns
- OOH Provider Queue Management- Filter by site types, IOS column in grids; IOS Dropdown in OOH Asst. YL Referral, TJCR,
- UM Form- new IOS
- CON Form- New IOS
- Provider Welcome Page YL Grids
- YouthLink Referrals current IOS of RTC will be updated to reflect the new IOS Admissions tab/Episode tab for transitioning youth
- Geo Mapping

FB 25815 WO 233544	<p>Enhancement: The CSA has requested a change in the logic to use Anniversary Date instead of due date when checking if there is a Prog Note Exception for bypassing the CMO Annual Review Treatment Plan for 2017.</p>
FB 14315 WO 126879 WO 233490	<p>Issue: OOH users can submit the JCR directly to the CSA without sending the Treatment Plan to the open CMO Agency for review.</p> <p>Resolved: The hierarchy for the JCR Treatment Plans is working as expected and are sent to the CMO prior to being sent to the CSA for review.</p>

<p>FB 25811 WO 233984</p>	<p>Issue: When a user creates and Episode for an OOH Admission the Add/Edit Admissions data does not match what is displayed in the Episodes grid of the youth's record.</p> <p>Resolved: The Episodes grid and Add/Edit Admissions screen are displaying the same data as expected.</p>
<p>FB 26235</p>	<p>Issue: CABS status is missing for electronically submitted CABS in the CAMP Welcome Page grid</p> <p>Resolved: When the CABS is received through an application, the status is displayed as SUBMITTED. When this submitted CABS is approved by CSOC, the status is set as APPROVED.</p>
<p>FB 26214</p>	<p>Issue: A Camp application has a One-To-One Request with a NON-QUALIFIED Provider. The REVIEW FORM for the application displays, "YES" in the Qualified One-To-One Provider field.</p> <p>Resolved: When a QUALIFIED or NON-QUALIFIED ONE-TO-ONE Provider is added To the application, the Qualified Provider field now displays YES for Qualified and NO for NON-QUALIFIED Providers.</p>
<p>FB 26212</p>	<p>Issue: The Camp Application status pop-up displayed all Camp Request OVERNIGHT DATES as '0'</p> <p>Resolved: OVERNIGHT and DAY DATES are both displayed accurately in the pop-status for the CAMP Application.</p>
<p>FB 26238</p>	<p>Issue: The CAMP Welcome Page grid is taking 50+ seconds to load for the CSA and CSOC users.</p> <p>Resolved: The stored procedure which controls this load time, "usp_Doc_Camp_HeaderWP" has been restructured and the load time is now under 5 seconds in all environments tested.</p>
<p>FB 26234</p>	<p>Issue: In the CAMP Welcome Page as a CSOC user, the vertical scroll bar is missing.</p> <p>Resolved: The scrollbar has been restored for use by CSOC and CSA users alike.</p>
<p>FB 26213</p>	<p>Issue: If a user creates a CAMP application, then uses SAVE & CLOSE, the Application status is IN-PROGRESS on the portal side, but displays, "PENDING"</p>

FB 26239	<p>Issue: When CSA or CSOC users attempt to PRINT the CAMP Welcome Page grid content, no print report is issued.</p> <p>Resolved: The print report is now called and contains the expected content.</p>
FB 26241	<p>Issue: CSOC users are unable to view UPLOADED documents in the CABS tab of the Camp Application.</p> <p>Resolved: CSOC users are now able to view any and all UPLOADED documents as expected.</p>
FB 26210	<p>Enhancement: During the Camp 1.44.0.0 release, there was an UAT request to have the Camp Service Application grid added into Forms drop-down menu and have the ability to add new Camp application directly from there.</p>
